Most Productive Waterfowl and Upland Game Areas

The northwestern part of North Dakota is the beginning of the Menedosa Pothole country, one of the most productive waterfowl areas to be found anywhere in North America. Mouse River Outfitters has access to these wetlands, plus many more acres of upland game private land.

Tens of Thousands of Geese

Every fall, tens of thousands of snow geese, blue geese, Canada geese and ducks choose the fertile prairie wheat lands as a staging area for their southerly migrations. While the snows, blues, Canada's and ducks are our main focus, afternoons will provide you the opportunity to hunt partridge and grouse as well. Also ask about our pheasant hunting!



The Expertise

While there are more birds than ever before, there is little question that the birds are getting smarter. However, surrounded by two large federal refuges, Mouse River Outfitters will have access to as many as 750,000 geese as they make their first stop on their southbound migrations. For Hollis Larson and Danny Schreckenbach, hunting these wonderful birds is not really a sport . . . it's a science. With literally thousands of acres of grain to feed on, the secret of this adventure is to be mobile. Each Mouse River Outfitter guide will have his own trailer with 50 - 100 dozen full-bodied and silhouette decoys.

The primary component of Mouse River Outfitters success is the ability to scout. Each afternoon Mouse River Outfitters' guides drive three to five hours to find the perfect field for the next day's hunt. This tedious task is a lot more complicated than just finding birds. It is imperative to find the right field, to choose the exact spot (that you will need to find long before daylight the next morning), and to take into consideration the wind and the flight patterns of the tens of thousands of geese as they leave the refuge to feed. Often, a sudden weather change makes it necessary to rethink your strategy. That is why every guide must choose not one, but multiple fields for the next day's shoot.

Once the decoys are set, it won't take long until these majestic birds set their wings and the action begins. The only thing left is to pull the trigger. The success or failure of that endeavor is up to you.

The Right Equipment

There is no short cut when it comes to defining the "right way" when hunting ducks or geese. Four-wheel drive vehicles, custom-built decoy trailers, Final Approach Chairs, gun stakes, custom camouflage covers and hundreds of decoys

per spread, are fitting examples of our commitment to be the best.

Snapshot of an Extraordinary Hunting Day ...

4:30 a.m.

Morning starts early here on the prairie. Once you've got your feet on the floor and selected your attire for the morning's hunt, you'll find breakfast and hot coffee waiting. After breakfast, your guide will be waiting to head out to the field.

6:00 a.m.

You'll be in the field and carefully setting your spread. For many of our guests, this never-perfect art form is one of the great challenges in the sport of hunting. Your guide will share many years of trial and error as he places over 300 full-bodied decoys, to attract flocks of birds that will soon fill the sky.

7:00 a.m.

Your heart will be pounding as you hear the first call of incoming geese. Now it's time to wait, gun in hand, until you hear the words, "Take 'em."

1:00 p.m.

It's time to pull your spread and head back to town. Once you've changed your clothes, we'll break for lunch.

3:00 p.m.

After a nice lunch in town, we will head back out to the field for an afternoon upland hunt for grouse and pheasant.

7:00 p.m.

Enjoy your favorite beverage in our cocktail bar and share the adventures of the day's hunt with your friends. After a few refreshments, dinner is available featuring a variety of excellent entrees each evening. One thing is certain, you won't go to bed hungry.

CAUTION!

The balance of the evening is up to you. Party if you can, but keep 4:30 a.m. in mind ... it comes pretty early.

Accommodations

Just twenty-one miles from the Canadian border, Kramer is situated minutes from the finest waterfowl hunting anywhere in the country. And our pheasant camp is in the midst of what we call pheasant heaven - the Richardton/Regent area! A comfortable, modern facility, and a courteous professional staff combine to make your stay at either camp perfect in every way.

Travel Arrangements:

Rest assured, the airports of Minot and Bismarck, North Dakota, offer many flights daily to accommodate your travel, and get you hunting when you're ready. Waterfowl or upland game, we'll get you there!

Deposit:

A deposit in the amount of \$500 per person is required within 10 days of making your reservation. Final payment is due the first day of your hunt.

Mouse River now offering Deer Hunting to round out your hunt!

Mouse River Outfitters is now offering hunts for Deer. Big game hunters will be placed in pre-scouted tree stands near a food plot or feeder. Deer hunts can be guided or unguided, based on the needs of the hunter and the animal being hunted. Hunters will generally be dropped off before daylight and picked up at a pre-designated time. They will then have lunch back in town and then head back out for the afternoon hunt. Hunters will be allowed to switch stands if requested. If you bag your deer early, you are welcome to stay and hunt waterfowl or grouse and partridge for the rest of your trip at no extra charge. (License excluded)
